



CASHMERE CARE GUIDE

WASH AND DRY

- Close buttons and turn garment inside out
- Use liquid mild detergent (e.g. from FTC®)
- Cold wool wash cycle (max. temperature 30°C)
- Spin max. 400 rpm
- Air dry: place clothes on clothes rack

CARE

- Knits should be stored lying flat, not hanging.
- Do not wash cashmere too often, airing also helps.
- Steam your cashmere styles from time to time to revitalize cashmere and restore the material's natural moisture. The heat from the steam kills bacteria and prevents moth cases.
- If pilling knots* form, carefully remove them using the FTC® Pilling Comb.

*Did you know that pilling is a natural characteristic of Cashmere?
The pilling is caused by the natural friction of the fine fibers
and therefore pilling is not a quality defect.
